Bro. George Szabolcsi was born in Budapest, Hungary. After immigrating to the USA he first settled in Ohio 1963-1972. From 1972 till 1979, he served in the US Air Force and is a Vietnam War Era Veteran.

While stationed at an Air Base in Illinois, in 1976, he began attending Apostolic Church of Belleville. He met, and married, his wife Dorie in 1979. Three children were born into this happy union; Amy, Jonathan and Sonya.

Bro. Szabolcsi graduated from Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville with a B.A. in Secondary Education. Entered the ministry 1983. Taught social studies in the public schools from 1985 till 1987.

The Szabolcsi's were appointed as Missionaries to Eastern Europe in 1987 and served until January 31, 2001. Bro. Szabolcsi began serving as Assistant Pastor to G.E Switzer in 2001.
